To the attention of arriving and departing passengers at Gnassingbé Eyadema International Airport

1- Arriving passengers:

a- For travellers arriving in Togo and presenting proof of complete vaccination, the PCR test is no longer required as a travel health document. In addition, it is no longer required to perform the PCR test upon arrival.

b- For non-vaccinated travellers arriving in Togo, proof of a negative PCR test is still required as a travel health document. These travellers will therefore be subjected to a PCR test at the airport.

2- Departing passengers:

a- Travellers with proof of full vaccination are exempted from PCR test to a country that does not require it as an entry health document.

b- For non-vaccinated travellers, proof of a negative PCR test is required as a travel health document.

3-The validity of the PCR test results is five (5) days.
